MEETINGS

Guests are always welcome. Meetings are usually held the second weekend of each month, September through June. General meetings provide an opportunity to learn, to share and to socialize with others interested in the calligraphic arts.

Programs are varied and can include lectures, audiovisual presentations, hands-on projects, demonstrations and information on activities, tools and techniques. Our meetings feature local presenters, as well as out-of-town guest instructors.
