As you read through this, please consider which piece(s) of your art you would like to exhibit. For those of you who have not exhibited before, this is a wonderful opportunity! It would be great if we could present at least one piece of work from each member. **All members are encouraged to display work . . . and all levels are welcome!**

Entry Requirements: Flat pieces must be framed behind glass or Plexiglas and wired on the back for hanging. Wire must be taut and no lower than a quarter of the way down from the top. 3D items such as books or cards will be displayed in enclosed podiums. Exhibit pieces on canvas do not require framing, but do require finished edges and wire for hanging. Submissions: Items to consider can be anything from a finished piece of art, a work in progress, or a class assignment/homework that you like. Perhaps you have a project that you have done in a recent workshop that you want to share. Do not hesitate to submit a piece of art that you have shown before. Our goal is to display a diversity of skill levels and experience of all our members. Each piece displayed will be accompanied by an informational label with the artist's name, title, description of the piece, and price or NFS (Not for Sale). Number of works and fees: No more than 3 pieces per person. Each entry is \$5 to help with the expenses of the exhibit. **To encourage first time exhibitors – we will waive your fees!** Please make a note on your entry label if you are a first-timer. Checks should be made out to SDFC.
