

Pen and Flat Brush Lettering (a variation of Roman)

MATERIALS

- ¼ or 1/8" grid paper is best; smaller grids would be hard on your eyes.
- Pencils
- Eraser
- C-thru ruler or other ruler of choice.(C-thru lets you see the grid as you work)
- Fountain pen, felt tip pen, dip pen and ink. Try them all! It's a good way to learn.)
- Paper towels
- ½" flat edged brush. (Winsor Newton is my personal choice.) Tole painting brushes can be good for lettering also. The main requirement is that the brush you choose must be able to spring back when you press it down with your fingers. We will not start day one using a brush, so you will have time to make your decision.
