Supply List

Pencils:

- Mechanical Pencil
- #2H pencil and 4H (regular - NOT mechanical)
- Daiso chiseled-edge mechanical pencil or Paper & Ink (optional)
- carbon pencil (**This may be optional. Some people have a hard time finding.**)

Paper:

- Photocopy paper (for practice) or what you already have
- 1 sheet Arches Text Wove - cut/tear into 8" x 6" pieces - fold to 4" x 6"
(subject to changes)
- 1 pc. card stock -- 2 pieces (4 1/8" x 6 1/8" will be stiffeners for our covers
Barbara will bring Tyvek for covers for final books

Other pens/tools:

- Calligraphy pens/markers (optional)
- a few colored pencils
- eraser, ruler
- package of paper stumps - small tortillons
- painters tape- 1" or 3/4" (blue) (**important to have**)
- #6 or comparable, water color brush; water container
- paper towels
- gel pen
- Stickles (optional)
- X-Acto knife, cutting mat
- embossing stylus
- thread (suggest: embroidery thread) your choice of color
- embroidery or tapestry needle
